Is a big car cheap? No, a big car isn't cheap,

but it's expensive.

a.m. p.m.

[er em] [pi: em]

noon [nu:n]

It's 3 a.m. (= before noon). It's 5 p.m. (= after noon).

What's the time? It's 10 a.m. or: It's 4 p.m.

Is it 10 p.m.? No, it isn't 10 p.m., but it's 10 a.m.

Is it 4 a.m.? No, it isn't 4 a.m., but it's 4 p.m.

What time is noon? | Noon is at 12 p.m.

Do we have our lesson at noon? Yes, we have our lesson at noon. or: No, we don't have our lesson

at noon.



What's the time? ~ It's 10 a.m. or: It's 4 p.m.
