Are you usually anxious about
the results of a test?

Yes, I'm usually **anxious** about the results
of a test.

or: No, I'm not usually **anxious** about ...

If you were about to travel into space,
would you be a little anxious about it?

Yes, if I were about to travel into space,
I'd be a little **anxious** about it.

or: No, if I were about to travel ...

Because *I wouldn't know what to expect.*

Because *I'd be very curious to see space.*

What do you think are the most
common anxieties of your parents?

I think the most common **anxieties** of my
parents are *my health, education and
safety.*

Are children always very anxious to
open Christmas presents?

Yes, children are always very **anxious** to
open Christmas presents.

Do most parents have a natural
anxiety to do the best for their
children?

Yes, most parents have a natural **anxiety**
to do the best for their children.

What's the difference between 'clothes'
and 'cloth'?

'Clothes' are what we wear and 'cloth'
is what we use for making 'clothes'.

What cloth are most clothes
like T-shirts made of?

Most clothes like T-shirts are made of
cotton **cloth**.

What would you clothe yourself in for
the celebration of the end of a school
year?

I'd **clothe** myself *in a white cotton T-shirt*
for the **celebration** of the end of a school
year.

Why can children be expensive
to clothe?

Children can be expensive to **clothe**
because *they need a change of clothing
almost every day, and also because they
grow up quickly.*
