money [ˈmʌni]
a pound [ə paʊnd]
a dollar [ə ˈdɒlə]
a euro [ə ˈjʊərəʊ]

- Do you have any money in your bag?** Yes, I have some **money** in my *bag*.
or: No, I don't have any **money** ...
- How much money do you have in your pocket?** I have *20 dollars* in my pocket.
- How many euros make a pound?** About *one and a half euros* make a **pound**.
- How many forints make a euro?** About *two hundred and sixty forints* make a **euro**.

a son [ə sʌn]
a daughter [ə ˈdɔ:tə]

- Are you a son?** Yes, I'm a **son**.
or: No, I'm not a **son**,
but I'm a **daughter**.
- Are you a daughter?** Yes, I'm a **daughter**.
or: No, I'm not a **daughter**,
but I'm a **son**.
- Does she have a son?** Yes, she has a **son**.
or: No, she doesn't have a **son**.
- Does he have a daughter?** Yes, he has a **daughter**.
or: No, he doesn't have a **daughter**.



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
