Do you return things to the shop when they're faulty ? Why?	Yes, I return things to the shop when they're faulty . Because <i>they should be faultless</i> .
Can you already speak faultless English? Why not?	No, I can't speak faultless English yet. Because <i>I still make some mistakes</i> .

Is this course a great opportunity to learn spoken English?	Yes, this course is a great opportunity to learn spoken English.
Is it a good idea to speak English at every opportunity ?	Yes, it's a good idea to speak English at every opportunity .
Do we have a lot of job opportunities in this town?	Yes, we have a lot of job opportunities in this town. <i>or: No, we don't have a lot of job ...</i>
Do you agree that a trip to Brazil would be a great holiday? Why? Why not?	Yes, I agree that a trip to Brazil would be a great holiday. <i>or: No, I don't agree that a trip ...</i> Because <i>Brazil is an interesting country</i> . Because <i>I think it is too hot in Brazil</i> .
