What sort of songs do you like I like singing pop songs. singing?

Yes, I often listen to techno music. or: No, I seldom listen to techno ...

Would you like to sing very well?

Yes, I would like to sing very well. or: No, I wouldn't like to sing very well.

What are the verb forms of 'sing'?

The verb forms of 'sing' are 'sing, sang, sung'.

Did you sing a lot when you were a child?

Yes, I sang a lot when I was a child. or: No, I didn't sing a lot when ...

singer [ˈsɪŋə] earn [s:n]

Who is your favourite singer? My favourite singer is James Blunt.

Do you think singers earn a lot of money?

Yes, I think singers earn a lot of money. or: No, I don't think singers earn ...

Would you like to earn money by singing?

Yes, I would like to earn money by singing. or: No, I wouldn't like to earn money ...
