kill	[kɪl]

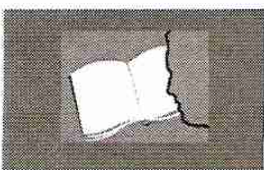
Is the wind sometimes **so** strong **that** it's difficult to walk? Yes, the wind is sometimes **so** strong **that** it's difficult to walk.

Is the choice in some shops **so** large **that** we can't make a decision? Yes, the choice in some shops is **so** large **that** we can't make a decision.

Are some animals **so** wild **that** they can **kill** people? Yes, some animals are **so** wild **that** they can **kill** people.

Is it ever right to **kill** a person? Yes, it's *sometimes* right to **kill** a person. *or:* No, it's *never* right to **kill** a person.
