- What can people have a fear of?** People can have a **fear** of *flying / losing a job / certain animals*.
- Do schoolchildren sometimes fear to tell their parents the truth about school marks?** Yes, schoolchildren sometimes **fear** to tell their parents the truth about school marks.
- Why do some people fear dogs?** Some people **fear** dogs perhaps because they've been **scared** seriously by one.
- Do you scare easily?** Yes, I **scare** easily.
or: No, I don't scare easily.
- Can high prices sometimes scare people off?** Yes, high prices can sometimes **scare** people off.
- What's your greatest fear?** My greatest **fear's** *the unknown*.
- Would it be scary if you woke up and found out you were lying in a coffin?** Yes, it'd be **scary** if I woke up and found out I was lying in a **coffin**.
or: No, it wouldn't be scary if I woke ...

environment [ɪn'vaɪrənmənt]
nuclear power ['nju:kliə 'paʊə]
solar power ['səʊlə 'paʊə]
recycle [ri:'saɪkl]

- Which is safer for the environment: nuclear power or solar power?** **Solar power's** safer for the environment than **nuclear power**.
- Are natural resources always safe for the environment?** Yes, natural resources are always safe for the **environment**.
or: No, natural resources aren't ...
- How can we all take care of the environment?** We can all take care of the **environment** *by using things that can be recycled / by using paper bags instead of plastic ones*.
- What can we recycle?** We can **recycle** *paper and glass*.
