PARENT What's the plural of "child"?

CHILD The plural of "child" is "children".

CHILDREN

The plural of **child** is irregular. We say **1 child** but **2 children**.

Mr and Mrs Green are parents. Tom and Betty are their children.

WHO ARE MR AND MRS GREEN?

Mr and Mrs Green are the parents.

WHO ARE TOM AND BETTY?

Tom and Betty are the children.

ARE YOU A PARENT?

No, I'm not a parent, but I'm a child.

HOW MANY CHILDREN HAVE YOUR PARENTS GOT?

My parents have got ... children.

or My parents have got one child.
