cheap [tʃi:p]
expensive [ik'spensiv]

- Is *this pen* cheap?** Yes, *this pen* is **cheap**.
- Are *these shoes* expensive?** Yes, *these shoes* are **expensive**.
- Is *this pencil* expensive?** No, *this pencil* isn't **expensive**, but it's **cheap**.
- Is a big car cheap?** No, a big car isn't **cheap**, but it's **expensive**.

a.m. [ei em]
p.m. [pi: em]
noon [nu:n]

It's 3 a.m. (= before noon). It's 5 p.m. (= after noon).

- What's the time?** It's **10 a.m.** or: It's **4 p.m.**
- Is it 10 p.m.?** No, it isn't **10 p.m.**, but it's **10 a.m.**
- Is it 4 a.m.?** No, it isn't **4 a.m.**, but it's **4 p.m.**
- What time is noon?** **Noon** is at **12 p.m.**
- Do we have our lesson at noon?** Yes, we have our lesson at **noon**.
or: No, we don't have our lesson at **noon**.



What's the time?
~ It's **10 a.m.** or: It's **4 p.m.**
